## Enlargements and renovations of buildings for knowledge transfer of folk craft arts

## in the Folk Art House of Mátraderecske and the Traditional House Palóc Gallery of Recsk

The mission of the Foundation for Nurturing Traditional Values is to protect architectural and tangible heritage, to present and operate exhibition places and craftsmanship and creativity facilities, to organise and implement professional and cultural programmes, conferences, events, courses and camps as special educational forms, in line with its foundation deed. Our board of trustees deems necessary the education of craftsmanship, especially the old "endangered" trades like weaving, embroidery, carving, furniture painting, basketry or leather goldsmith, and the promotion of creative activities to different age groups.

To accomplish this, we need to create and develop training spaces. Therefore we participate in the **INTERREG Slovakia - Hungary building partnership** programme as project partner.
